Complete your ASD properly and there'll be no comebacks



Completing an Animal Status Declaration when you move cattle or deer is vital in the fight against bovine tuberculosis (TB). Ensuring all the information is correct is important as it is a legal requirement. Stock buyers and carriers can refuse to accept stock or return stock without a signed and completed ASD. That's a cost you could do without, so make sure your ASDs are complete, accurate and signed and there'll be no comebacks.
